New Jersey's membership decision was especially driven by the needs of beekeepers who wanted to register the locations of their apiaries. "Integrating technology with best practices gives our New Jersey beekeepers another tool to secure sustainable agriculture here in the Garden State," New Jersey Secretary of Agriculture Douglas Fisher said. "I am looking forward to this partnership with FieldWatch, Inc."
