Help Pesticide Applicators Avoid Your Hives

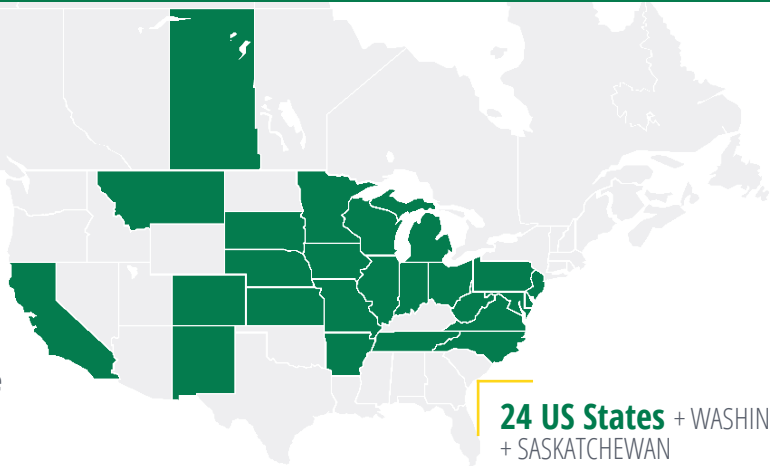

FieldWatch is a trusted source of crop and apiary data in North America promoting sustainability for pollinators, plants and people.

- FieldWatch operates a registry dedicated to beekeepers called **BeeCheck**[™].
- FieldWatch offers free, accurate and secure online tools with an easy-to-use Google Maps[™] interface.

Map the locations of your hives in the BeeCheck online registry. Pesticide applicators can consult this registry before spraying to improve decision-making and minimize damage from spray drift.

- Beehive placement can be done via GPS or manual "point 'n click" with mouse – no drawing required.
- Beehive sites are approved and validated by your state's Department of Agriculture.
- You can add multiple hives in one submission.
- Time Stamp feature can be used to indicate active dates in a particular location.
- Posting on the public map is optional. Map and contact information can be limited to applicators registered with FieldWatch.
